For 28 seasons the Gulf Coast Symphony has made good on its promise to you – to play the music you love to hear. And this season will be no different. With nearly 100 days of entertainment, we offer something for everyone. Jazz, Ballet, Opera, Musical Theater, Symphonic Pops, Orchestral Classics and Chamber Music provide you with many great choices of some of the best professional musical performances you can hear in Southwest Florida at two great venues: the Barbara B. Mann Performing Arts Hall and the more intimate 300 seat theater at the Gulf Coast Symphony's Music & Arts Community Center (MACC).

Musicals at the MACC brings a season of hilarious comedies to Fort Myers. These professional productions allow our audiences to experience the best of Broadway right in our own backyard. We open our musical season with the world premiere of **Snowbird Follies**, a new musical revue co-written by me and the brilliant director, choreographer and writer D.J. Salibury that is whimsical musical yuletide celebration with a winking nod to Fort Myers' original snowbirds, Thomas Edison and Henry Ford. And, our new production of the classic musical **GYPSY** at the Barbara B. Mann Performing Arts Hall, starring Tony award winner, and Disney's royalty, the original voice of the Little Mermaid, Jodi Benson as Mama Rose, promises a once-in-a-lifetime experience.

The Gulf Coast Chamber Orchestra, now in its third season, is the orchestra in residence at the MACC. Our commitment to showcase works of great classical masters, alongside those of living composer, woman composers and composers of color continues this season, with works by Beethoven, Mozart, Mendelsohn, Price, Farrerc, Montgomery, Theofandis, Higdon and more. This flexible sized ensemble (from 30 to 48 players) will also perform with the Fort Myers Symphonic Mastersinger and Gulfshore Ballet.

The Gulf Coast Symphony's Symphonic Pop Series at Barbara B. Mann Performing Arts Hall continues to bring international stars to our community. **The Doo Wop Project** features performers from Broadway's *MoTown: The Musical* and *Jersey Boys*. Tony-award winner Bryce Pinkham and his wife, double Olivier nominee Scarlet Strallen present **From Broadway to the West End: A Love Story**. In March, Grammy & Tony nominee Michael Cavanaugh returns with the **Music of Paul Simon, James Taylor and Neil Diamond**. In April the symphony features the music of Andrew Lloyd Webber with **Music of the Night** with GCS favorites Hugh Panaro and Christiane Noll. And, the magic of *Cirque* returns with an all-new show **Cirque Goes to the Movies!** Our Barbara B. Mann PAH season ends with a full production of Verdi's beloved opera **A Masked Ball (Un Ballo in Maschera)**.



Here we meet Reverend Mother Regina, a former circus performer; Sister Mary Hubert, the Mistress of Novices; a streetwise nun from Brooklyn named Sister Robert Anne; Sister Mary Leo, a novice who is a wannabe ballerina; and the delightfully wacky Sister Mary Amnesia, the nun who lost her memory when a crucifix fell on her head.

FARRENC SYMPHONY NO. 3 • JANUARY 14 | 7:30

Symphony No. 3 in G minor, is a work by Louise Farrenc, the last of the symphonies she composed. It is the best known and most appreciated of her symphonies. Although less performed and recorded, it is nevertheless compared by the music journalist Tom Service to the symphonies of Felix Mendelssohn and Robert Schumann.

VIVALDI GLORIA with FORT MYERS SYMPHONIC MASTERSINGERS FEBRUARY 11 | 7:30

Fort Myers Master Singers join Gulf Coast Chamber Orchestra for a night of Vivaldi's Gloria. Vivaldi's Gloria is one of sacred music's most uplifting choral works – a piece of high drama and hidden performers.

DVORÁK SYMPHONY NO. 7 • MARCH 25 | 7:30

Dvorak's seventh symphony in succession, written in D minor, enjoys a special status in the composer's series of nine symphonies. Its gloomy atmosphere is in direct contrast not only to its two neighboring symphonies (Nos. 6 and 8), but also to the large majority of Dvorak's oeuvre as a whole. It is characteristic for its dramatic expression and somber atmosphere of grave uncertainty and obstinate defiance. It is distinguished for its absence of any Slav-inspired melodies which were characteristic for the composer's preceding Slavic period and with which his compositional style is usually associated.

A GULF COAST SYMPHONY EDUCATION INITIATIVE

To eliminate the barriers to arts education, the Gulf Coast Symphony created MusicWorks!, a daily instrumental music program that uses music as an instrument for social transformation, empowering children to acquire values and achieve their full potential, positively affecting their society through the study and performance of music.

MusicWorks! program provides students with the tools necessary to motivate each child to fulfill their full potential. Students are provided with instruments, instructors, and materials needed to be successful in their musical studies. MusicWorks! is unique in that our program is daily for 1.5 hours, which allows our Teaching Artists to be embedded in the community. Students (grades 2-6) will learn an instrument from the string family and perform as a string orchestra and in smaller string ensembles.

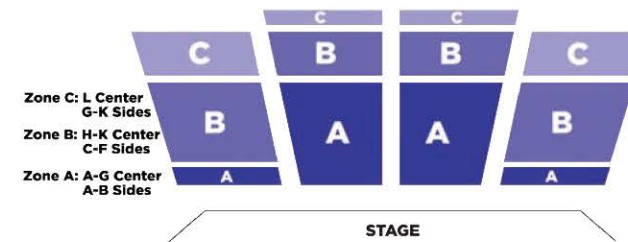
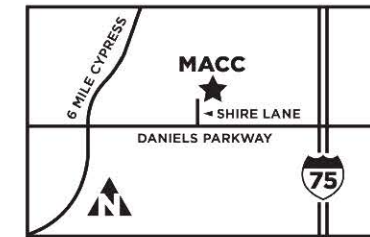

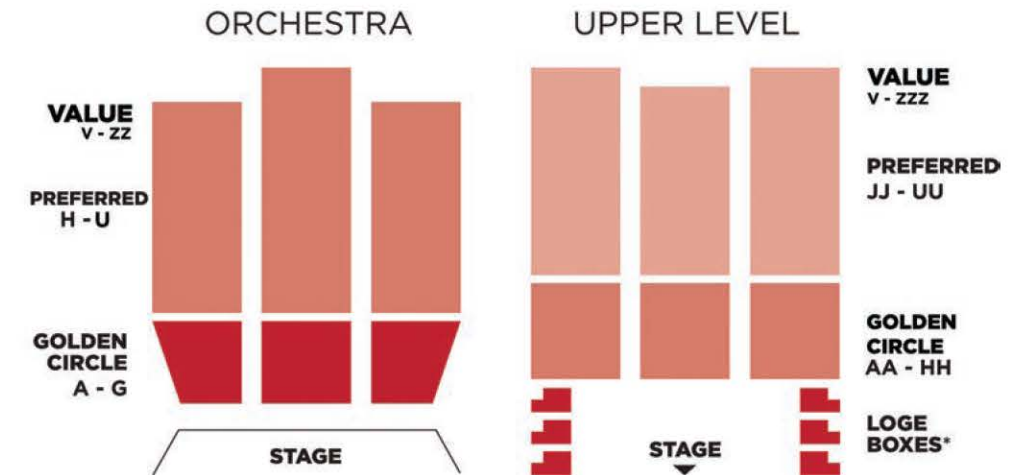
